SAL-004 D	<b>Sarracenia alata black Tube- J. Newman</b> <i>Grands tubes très foncés. Très joli clone.</i>	20		
SAL-009 B	<b>Sarracenia alata var.atrorubra (red tube)-Deer park-Al</b> <i>This unusual red form of S.alata is a little slower growing than the green of yellow pitched forms, pale cream flowers in the early Spring.</i>	20
